

	<ul> <li>Perform servicing, maintenance, trouble shooting and repairs on plant, equipment and parts as follows:</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Observe mechanical devises in operation and listen to locate causes of trouble</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Dismantle devices to gain access to and remove defective parts</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Examine form and texture of parts to detect imperfections</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Inspect used parts to determine changes in dimensional requirements</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Adjust functional parts of devices and control instruments</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Repair or replace defective parts in plant and equipment</li> </ul>
Mechanical Duties	<ul> <li>Install special functional and structural parts in devices</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Start devices to test their performance</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Dismantle components and machinery</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Lubricate and clean parts</li> </ul>
	Set up and operate lathe, drill press, grinder and other metalworking tools to make and repair parts
	<ul> <li>Servicing of Company vehicles as required</li> </ul>
	Perform quality checks on new and second hand parts prior to installation in machinery
	Perform Mechanic – Dismantling duties when required for operational reasons

	Advise second hand stores staff of parts required to conduct repairs and process return of unused parts correctly

Quality Control	In cooperation with your Manager, proactively identify and implement best practice and high-quality processes and systems	
	<ul> <li>Continually monitor quality in relation to second hand parts (both parts and processes)</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Adhere to all company policies in relation to quality control and follow established systems and procedures</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Complete all relevant documentation and reporting relating to quality control as required</li> </ul>	
	Comply with any relevant legislation, standards, and codes of practice applicable to your work

Experience & Qualifications	<ul> <li>Sound mechanical knowledge in relation to earthmoving equipment</li> <li>Current Forklift License</li> <li>Trade Qualifications as a General or Diesel Mechanic</li> <li>Current, Valid Drivers' License (desirable)</li> <li>Current Crane and/or Dogger Operator License (desirable)</li> </ul>
